Finn Juhl møbler i fint selskab med Mrs. og Mr. Obama

Onecollection leverer møbler til både IOC-konferencen i oktober og klimatopmødet i december...



Onecollection fra Ringkøbing indretter eksklusiv VIP Lounge med Finn Juhl møbler til den internationale olympiske komités konference i Bella Center 1.-9. oktober, hvor blandt andre Michelle og Barack Obama, kong Juan Carlos fra Spanien samt Pélé er prominente deltagere.

-Der er faktisk tale om en hel kavalkade af arkitekt Finn Juhls kendteste møbler, som skal bruges til VIP-loungens 40 siddepladser, fortæller Henrik Sørensen, direktør i designmøbelfirmaet Onecollection, Ringkøbing.

Arkitekten Finn Juhl (1912-1989) var den af de store danske arkitekter, der blev mest kendt internationalt, og derfor faldt det naturligt at vælge netop hans møbler til IOC's konference.

Blandt møblerne er flere nyheder, som for eksempel Baker-sofaen, som vises for første gang i brug efter relanceringen under CODE 09 i august.

-Det er faktisk en lidt finurlig historie, for den amerikansk producerede Baker-sofa blev præsenteret første gang i Chicago i 1951, Michelle og Barack Obama kommer fra Chicago, og byen er nu i spil som mulig vært for de olympiske lege i 2016, forklarer Henrik Sørensen.

Ud over Baker-sofaen anvendes Høvdingestolen fra 1949, Pelikan-stolen og Poet-sofaen fra henholdsvis 1940 og 1941 samt 45-stolen fra 1945.

-I dag står Finn Juhls designs som noget af det mest eksklusive, man kan få. Da Onecollection for ti år siden overtog rettighederne til Finn Juhls møbler, var han nærmest ukendt i den brede offentlighed og kun kendt blandt møbelkendere. I dag er han højaktuel, siger Henrik Sørensen.

Ikke mindst på grund af sit virke i USA, betragtes Finn Juhl i dag som faderen til begrebet "Danish Design".

Siddepladser til klimatopmødet

Til FN's klimatopmøde i København i december har Onecollection sikret sig leverancen af 2000 Bessi stole

tegnet af den islandske arkitekt Erla Oskarsdottir samt 300 specialudviklede borde.

-Der er tale om brugsmøbler, hvor bæredygtighed og komfort er i højsædet, de er lette at flytte rundt med og så er de oven i købet æstetisk smukke. Så vi er sikre på, at mødedeltagerne kommer til at sidde både behageligt og bæredygtigt under de vigtige klimaforhandlinger, siger Henrik Sørensen.

Bordene er lavet i dansk ask, en ressource som er lokal og som bør anvendes nu. Ask er nemlig angrebet af sygdommen toptørre, som på sigt vil udrydde træsorten helt. Bordpladen er beklædt med linoleum, som er et naturprodukt lavet af blandt andet linolie og sand, der ikke

kræver anden behandling end vedligeholdelse med sæbespånvand.

-Man har fundet det vigtigt at tænke bæredygtighed ind i møblerne qua den globale opvarmning, som er temaet for topmødet, siger Henrik Sørensen.

Stolene er da også blevet valgt, netop fordi de kan ændres og genanvendes til andre formål efter topmødet. Sæde og ryg kan skiftes ud, så stellet kan genbruges i stedet for blot at blive kasseret.

Finn Juhl furniture in company with Mrs. og Mr. Obama

Onecollection will be delivering furniture for both the IOC conference in October and for the Climate Summit in December...



Onecollection from Ringkøbing is furnishing the exclusive VIP lounge with Finn Juhl furniture for the International Olympic Committee's conference in Bella Center from 1st to 9th October, where among others Michelle and Barack Obama, King Juan Carlos from Spain and Pelé are prominent participants.

-As a matter of fact we are talking of a cavalcade of Finn Juhl's most known furniture, which we are using for the 40 seats in the VIP lounge, tells Henrik Sørensen, Managing Director of the design-furniture company Onecollection, Ringkøbing.

The architect Finn Juhl (1912-1989) was the one of the great Danish architects, who got most known internationally, and so it was a natural thing choosing his furniture for the IOC conference.

Among the furniture there is more news, like e.g. the Baker couch which is going to be used for the first time since the re-launching during CODE 09 in August.

-There is actually a good story behind this, as the first American produced Baker couch was introduced for the first time in Chicago in 1951, Michelle and Barack Obama come from Chicago, and now the city is in the game as possible host city for the Olympic games in 2016, explains Henrik Sørensen.

Besides the Baker couch, the Chieftain chair from 1949, the Pelican chair from 1940, the Poet sofa from 1941 and the 45-chair from 1945 are used.

Today Finn Juhl's designs are some of the most exclusive design you can get. Ten years ago when Onecollection got the rights to Finn Juhl's furniture he was fairly unknown to the broader public and only known among the carpenters. Today he is very topical, says Henrik Sørensen.

Not at least because of his work in USA Finn Juhl is considered as the father of the concept of "Danish Design".

Seatings at the Climate Summit

For the UN Climate Summit in Copenhagen in December Onecollection has secured the delivery of 2000 Bessi chairs designed by the Icelandic designer Erla Oskársdóttir, as well as 300 special made tables.

-Here we are talking furniture for use, with comfort and sustainability above all, they are easy to move around and then they are also aesthetic beautifully. So we are sure the participants at the meeting will be seated comfortably and sustainably during the important climate negotiations says Henrik Sørensen.

The tables are made in Danish ashwood, a resource which is local and should be used now. The ash is attacked by the disease topdryness, which is going to wipe out the

wood sort completely in time. The tableplate is covered with linoleum, which is a natural product made among others things of linseed oil and sand and it does not require any other maintenance than soap flakes in water.

-One has found it important to think sustainability into the furniture qua the global heating which is the theme of the meeting, says Henrik Sørensen.

The chairs were also chosen because they can be changed and used for other purposes after the summit. Seat and back can be changed, so the frame can be re-used instead of being scraped.
